(S) Subject is [United Arab Republic (UAR) Military  
Attache, Washington, D.C., concerning whom we have a pending  
security investigation to determine if he is engaged in intelli-  
gence activities. Washington Field Office (WFO) report dated  
11/17/59 contains information from CS WF [1014-S] that subject  
recently was a cosigner for a \$200 loan for [Robin Webb, a secretary  
in the Office of the UAR Air Attache. In addition, CS WF [1014-S] (S)  
advised subject reportedly loaned [Webb] \$50 to open a checking  
account at Riggs National Bank. Informant said this was the first  
time, to informant's knowledge, that [an Arab] at [UAR Embassy] has  
loaned money to an American employee and it appeared to informant  
that a close association appeared to be developing between subject  
and [Robin Webb.] WFO advised it will be alert for additional  
information pertaining to relationship between [Webb] and subject. (S)

In cover pages to its report of 11/17/59, WFO furnished  
following information concerning [Robin Webb] made available by  
[WF 1097-S\*] (S)

On 8/24/59 [WF 1097-S\*] advised Robin Webb indicated to  
her roommate she was having intimate relations with a married man named  
"Winnie" in his office and was afraid of being caught. She indicated  
she desired to obtain an apartment where they would not be bothered.  
On 8/26/59, according to [WF 1097-S\*] Webb contacted Vincent Welch  
at Welch, Mott and Morgan, Attorneys, 710 14th Street, N.W.,  
Washington, D.C., and agreed to meet with him the following night.  
Welch indicated he was happy to hear Webb was moving into a new  
apartment. (S)

With regard to Vincent B. Welch, WFO advised credit  
report dated 5/14/53 indicated Welch has been an attorney with  
firm of Welch, Mott and Morgan since 1947 and as of 1953 was married  
to Barbara G. Welch, psychotherapist at Providence Hospital,  
Washington, D.C. (Above law firm is the firm of Edward P. Morgan,  
former Special Agent who resigned 3/15/47 at which time he was an  
inspector.) Our files indicate that Welch on 4/8/41 made application  
for position of Special Agent with the Bureau. He was not granted  
employment inasmuch as unfavorable information was disclosed during  
the investigation indicating that he was a "scatterbrain."

On 9/1/59 [WF 1097-S] (S) obtained information that Robin Webb was contacted by Congressman Torbert Kurt Macdonald (Democrat-Massachusetts) who indicated he would like to "get back on the once a week meeting" with Webb. Webb refused to see Macdonald stating she was "going with Vinnie" until the end of the year. Macdonald chided her that "Vinnie" would not marry her. This informant advised 9/3/59 that Robin Webb agreed to have a drink with Congressman Macdonald prior to his leaving on an extended trip. (S)

With regard to Macdonald, our files indicate he applied for position as Special Agent with Bureau December, 1941, but the investigation discontinued because he was friendly with one Inga Arvad, then a suspected espionage agent. (Subsequent investigation concerning Arvad failed to develop any espionage activities on her part.) [James Angleton of Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) 4/16/56 confidentially advised that Macdonald was having an affair with Elizabeth DeCroy, a Belgium national who is sometimes called a princess because of reported royalty background. Angleton said he has been informed Macdonald has ambitions of becoming Governor of Massachusetts and he reportedly was introduced to Miss DeCroy by Senator John Kennedy of Massachusetts.] Macdonald is married and has three children. (S)

Our files contain no information identifiable with Robin Webb but, on basis of above information, it appears the subject's interest in her is most likely social in nature.
