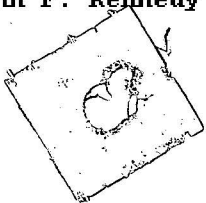

DON REYNOLDS visited his residence on 6/18/67. He has known REYNOLDS, age about 60, since REYNOLDS first came to Las Vegas about fifteen years ago from Fort Smith, Arkansas. REYNOLDS now solely owns newspapers, radio, and TV stations, and nineteen hundred billboards throughout the State of Nevada.

REYNOLDS related that about a week before he was in Washington, D. C. and received a call and met with Attorney EDWARD MORGAN of Washington, D. C. He knew MORGAN through source. MORGAN proposed the purchase of REYNOLDS' entire communications empire by HOWARD HUGHES for \$20,000,000. REYNOLDS replied that he had not considered selling but would think about it.

About a half hour later, REYNOLDS received a phone call from HANK GREENSPUN who was calling from the hotel lobby and wanted to speak to REYNOLDS. GREENSPUN was loaned money by source originally to buy the Las Vegas Sun newspaper. Later, source had encouraged REYNOLDS to purchase the opposition paper, the Las Vegas Review Journal.
