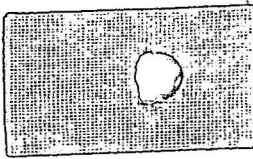
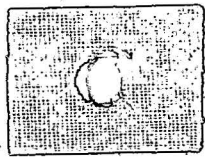

NOTE, LEGAT PARIS: (S)(U)

Enclosed for your information is a copy of the  
referenced communication. On June 21, 1960, CIA advised that  
it desired to pass the information to the DST of the Surete  
Paris. You should make the information concerning Morgan set  
forth in the attached communication available to the DST. The  
information in the enclosed memorandum concerning the subject  
should be unclassified. Determine DST interest in subject.

NOTE ON YELLOW:

Subject is a prominent pro-Castro leader who is  
presently in Cuba. He has an extremely unsavory background. CIA  
requested permission to furnish information originated with the  
Bureau to "French Services." We checked with CIA and we were  
advised on June 21, 1960, that the DST of the Surete was the  
French Service desiring the information. Since it is our  
information, it is felt we should have our representative in Paris  
pass this information. CIA classified its communication "Secret."  
MAIL ROOM  TELETYPE UNIT  Since the information originated with the  
Bureau and was unclassified, we should not put a classification on it.
