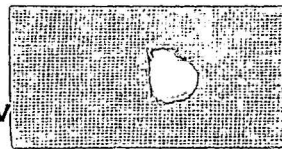
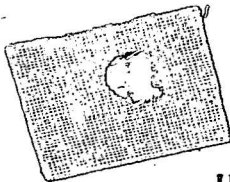

On 9/9/60 the Direction de la Surveillance du Territoire (DST), French domestic counterespionage service, expressed appreciation for the information furnished by the Bureau concerning WILLIAM MORGAN. (S)

Handwritten scribbles and initials

The DST advised that it became interested in receiving background information concerning MORGAN because of the fact that his signature appeared in a tract issued by the Directoire Revolutionnaire Iberique de Liberation (DRIL), a revolutionary organization for the liberation of the Iberian Peninsula. This movement, which appears to have originated in Cuba, has as its purpose the overthrow by violence of the FRANCO and SALAZAR regimes. (S)

The DST also stated that "Bohemia", a Cuban publication, reflected that one WILLIAM MORGAN, an American citizen, had lost his citizenship and was a Major in the Cuban Army. (S)

The DST advised that they had jumped to the conclusion that the WILLIAM MORGAN in Cuba and the signer of the DRIL tract were identical, and that it was for this reason that they had inquired concerning MORGAN. (S)
