On May 18, 1962, a confidential source abroad advised the above-captioned Cuban nationals were passengers on Czech Airlines Flight 524/02 from Havana, Cuba, to Prague, Czechoslovakia. On May 2, 1962, this flight landed at Halifax, Nova Scotia, on which date subjects sought political asylum. Subjects contended they had been making plans for defecting from Cuba for the past year and a half, and had made arrangements for a tourist trip from Cuba to Czechoslovakia. The trip was arranged through the tourist department of the Cuban Government and the tour was to cover 15 days in Czechoslovakia and 15 days in Russia. The trip although sponsored by the Cuban Government was paid for by the subjects. Both have expressed a desire to enter the U. S. (S)

Darias contends he married Rodriguez in Cuba on August 9, 1958. Darias states he was a supporter of Fidel Castro at the time of the revolution, but now feels Castro has lost control of the government to communists. He contends he is not sympathetic toward communism. (S)

Darias prepared a brief regarding Radio Havana Cuba, for which he was employed, as well as other data pertaining to Cuba. This brief includes his opinions and was originally prepared in Spanish in conjunction with the assistance of his wife translated into English. (S)

NOTE: RCMP furnished information regarding the defection of subjects at Halifax, Nova Scotia, while en route to Czechoslovakia. Subjects upon interview by Canadian migration officer furnished considerable data relative to Radio Havana, Cuba, and general conditions which exist there.
