Reference is made to your teletype dated June 28, 1962, captioned "(FNU) Mediavilla, Cuban G-2 Agent Employed at United Nations," your Out Number 98930. (S) (U)

Our files contain the following information concerning Gilberto Mediavilla de la Pena, born November 15, 1934, at Camaguey, Cuba, who appears identical with the subject of the referenced communication. (S) (U)

On October 14, 1960, a confidential source abroad advised that Mediavilla arrived in Madrid, Spain, on October 1, 1960, as one of a group of ten newspapermen and radio commentators en route to the Soviet Union. He reportedly possessed Cuban Passport Number E/60/413, which had been issued on September 8, 1960. On March 7, 1962, the Department of State advised that Mediavilla's name had been submitted for inclusion on the list of those entitled to diplomatic privileges and immunities and that he would be assigned to the Cuban Mission to the United Nations as Third Secretary. On March 29, 1962, the Immigration and Naturalization Service advised that Mediavilla had arrived in New York City to assume his duties. (S) (U)

Our memorandum dated June 11, 1962, at Newark, New Jersey, entitled "Duncan," a copy of which has been furnished your Agency, contained information indicating that Cuban Ambassador to the United Nations Mario Garcia Inchaustegui had told one of our sources that "Mediavilla" could contact our source away from the United Nations if our source did not care to come to the Ambassador's office in the future.

Enclosed is a copy of a memorandum dated June 21, 1962, at New York, New York, entitled "Cuban Mission to the United Nations, Internal Security - Cuba," which contains information concerning Mediavilla's involvement in a clandestine operation. We would appreciate receiving any additional data which your source might possess concerning the subject.
