On January 15, 1959, Mrs. Jane Roman, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), advised that her Agency had translated a teletype to the Bureau dated January 14, 1959, describing certain activities of the subject. It was her understanding that the teletype reflected that Guardia, a Panamanian, was traveling to Cuba, allegedly for the purpose of ascertaining from Castro representatives where and how the rebels obtained their arms and ammunition. He reportedly desired to obtain this information for a political group in Panama.

Mrs. Roman advised that Guardia is a CIA informant. The Agency did not want him to go on this particular mission but was unable to get word to him in sufficient time to stop the trip. He did get CIA instructions not to get involved in any negotiations but to develop information and to report to CIA.

Mrs. Roman stated that CIA would furnish the Bureau any pertinent information developed by Guardia.
