Austin Horn, CIA, furnished the following to the Liaison Agent on 8/29/63. *(S)(u)*

CIA has been informed by its representative in Montreal, Canada that the captioned individual possibly may leave Montreal for Cuba on September 2, 1963. At the present time, it is highly doubtful that he will be successful in obtaining passage. If he fails, the informant plans to communicate with friends in Havana and will appeal for assistance in obtaining passage on a ship leaving Canada for Cuba at the earliest possible date. CIA has worked out arrangements whereby the informant will telephonically communicate with a CIA representative in Washington, D. C., when he positively has obtained passage. CIA will keep the Bureau informed concerning informant's travel. *(S)(u)*
