It is requested that we be advised as to whether the source of the data regarding the subject is in the United States at the present time. If so, it is requested that we be advised as to whether you would make him available for interview by this Bureau. If he received his information from another source, we would appreciate being advised as to the identity of this other source and whether he would be available for interview by this Bureau.

NOTE: CIA letter 9/20/61 indicates that according to information dated 6/20/61 a fairly reliable source who is an employee of the Cuban Government advised that subject, a barber who owns a string of barbershops in Miami, works directly for Major Pineiro, one of leading Cuban G-2 officials. Letter indicates that the CIA source was unable to furnish any more details. Lack of identifying data regarding subject dictates that we should attempt to interview source or his original source especially in view of common name of subject residing in area where there are large number of individuals of Latin-American origin.
