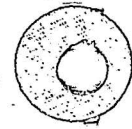
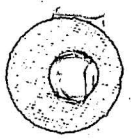

- January 1, 1961 2-2000 Call made by Ramon Pico or Ramon Vico at Roxbury number to Manuel Pico
- January 19, 1961 2-2000 Collect call made by Edmundo Bico to Antonio Bico or Antonio Vico at Roxbury number
- January 22, 1961 2-2275 Call made to Bexaida Gonzales (Phonetic)

We are interested in identifying the persons called in Cuba and in determining if any of the numbers contacted are establishments of the Cuban Government. It is requested that you furnish this Bureau any available data concerning the persons called in Cuba and whether the telephone numbers listed are establishments of the Cuban Government.

NOTE FOR SAC, BOSTON:

Reurlet 6/12/61. No cross telephone directories for Cuban telephone numbers are available at the Bureau. Any information received from CIA will be furnished to you.

NOTE ON YELLOW:

Boston obtained a list of telephone numbers made from subject's telephone, including numbers called in Cuba. Boston requested Bureau to determine if these numbers could be checked and to make available information obtained concerning persons called and whether the Cuban telephone numbers involved were known to be establishments of the Cuban Government.
