This will confirm information furnished to you
through liaison on July 11, 1961, your file CSCI 3/765,
922. (U)

Investigation to date has revealed that subject
traveled to the United States in January and May, 1961,
both times residing at the Columbus Hotel, Miami, Florida.
Information was developed that during her stay at this hotel
telephone calls were made from subject's room to telephone
numbers listed to Ralph Estrada, 344 Ocean Drive, Apartment 8,
Miami Beach, Florida, Vice President of Cuban Atlantic
Sugar Company; and to one Francisco Freire, 1802 S. W.
Sixth Street, Miami, Florida, who reportedly arrived
in the United States from Havana, Cuba, on November 7,
1960, as a political refugee. We are attempting to
develop additional information concerning Estrada and
Freire and pertinent information will be furnished to
you. In addition, we are attempting to determine whether
stops can be effectively placed and with adequate security
at the Columbus Hotel; Pan American World Airways, Miami,
Florida; and Cubana Airlines, New York City, to assist
us in ascertaining if subject or her husband returns to
the United States. In accordance with your request a
stop is not being placed in the Lookout Files of
Immigration and Naturalization Service.
