On 9/24/63, Austin Horn, CIA, made reference to the mention of the "Consuelo" in the ["Roberto"] traffic. Based upon recent CIA analysis, the Agency has come up with a preliminary conclusion that "Consuelo" is possibly identical with ~~Melva C. Garcia Arias~~, a Panamanian citizen who is closely connected with Theima King, a Panamanian well known to the Bureau. Information developed by CIA indicates that Melva was in Cuba for training during the period June-December, 1962. CIA coverage also indicated that Melva exited from Cuba in March or April of this year. According to Horn, subject's travel fits with information set forth in intercepted messages. (S)(u)

Horn advised that his Agency would appreciate receiving from the Bureau any available information which might be identifiable with Melva Garcia. (S)(u)
