COMMITTEES OF DEFENSE OF THE REVOLUTION

MM T-1, a former Cuban investigator with experience in both official police and private investigations, who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished the following data on July 19, 1962, concerning the Committees of Defense of the Revolution.

The Comites de Defensa De La Revolucioni (Committees of Defense of the Revolution) (CDR) are the civilian organizations used by the Government of Cuba for maintaining surveillance and control over the people. The committees are divided into two classes: first, those that are active in the residential areas; and, second, those which function in the work centers, offices, and branches of commerce. According to the official government disposition setting up the CDR, they perform the following functions:

FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEES IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS

Generally the CDR are distributed with one committee per block, but in some cases, as in sparsely populated areas, two or even three blocks may be included under the surveillance of one committee. The residential committee is to act as follows:

Maintain strict surveillance over the residents of the block, point out the activities of the residents, the visitors they receive, and how they express themselves regarding the revolution.
