Legat, Mexico, interviewed Counselor Mauri for two hours at the residence of the Italian Ambassador to Mexico, and Mr. Mauri has provided some observations regarding the Cuban Situation which are summarized in the enclosure and which are of considerable interest. The accordance with prior arrangements with the Attorney General and Deputy Under Secretary Johnson, they are receiving copies of the memorandum by separate cover letters. Legat is submitting a detailed memorandum concerning the interview in which Counselor Mauri's identity is concealed and the interested intelligence agencies will be furnished copies thereof.
