James Angleton, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA), advised on November 2, 1962, that the following had been directed to his attention by the local **MI-6** representative.

On October 26, 1962, the subject contacted an unidentified representative of the Washington Associated Press Office and asked urgently if this person could have lunch with him. During this luncheon, Fomin advanced to his unidentified guest the suggestion that Soviet dismantling of missile bases in Cuba might be considered in exchange for a U. S. pledge not to invade Cuba.

Angleton stated that in an effort to obtain more specifics he learned that the **MI-6** representative received this information from one Tom Brimelow who in turn obtained the data from Leon Volkov of Newsweek.
