NOTE FOR SAC, SAN JUAN, AND LEGAT, OTTAWA:

Re Ottawa airtel 10-16-63, a copy of which was forwarded to San Juan on 10-22-63. Under caption of "Travel Control - Cuba," Ottawa forwarded data which had been furnished by RCMP regarding subject's arrival in Canada from Cuba. Ottawa airtel 10-16-63 also indicated that subject, in conversation with an RCMP source, indicated he was connected with a trade union movement. Ottawa is in possession of a photograph of the subject.

Ottawa should promptly determine whether there is anyone who can identify subject (as actually having arrived in Canada from Cuba in 9/63) and is also available and willing to testify. Internal Security Division has inquired as to whether SJ T-1 mentioned in the report of SA John L. Spurgers, Jr., dated 12-27-62 is available and willing to testify. Cover page to that report indicated that this source "although willing to testify against the subject" did not feel he could do so in open court. Promptly contact this source and determine his present availability and willingness to testify. Ottawa and San Juan should afford this matter prompt attention.

NOTE: Subject is on Security Index and has made three trips to Cuba without State Department authorization. He arrived in Canada from Cuba on 9/63 and his present whereabouts is unknown. We know he was in Canada for twelve days and there is some indication he may have traveled to New York City. Our office there is checking this out. Request for availability of witnesses was made by Departmental Attorney W. Hipkiss to SA Boyd Adsit telephonically on 10-21-63. Hipkiss stated that a letter would be coming through confirming request for additional data re availability of sources.
