NOTE: Classified "Secret" since it refers to information so classified by CIA. According to Bureau Source 5 Deans was an MGB agent working in Mexico in 1944. It is believed that Deans was not this individual's true name. We have received information that he was not Spanish but was of English and French origin. Deans traveled through the United States in 1946 from Mexico and left New York on a Russian vessel. His whereabouts and activities since that time are unknown.
