The following information was furnished to the Liaison Agent on February 24, 1961, by Mrs. Jane Roman, Central Intelligence Agency (CIA). (S) (U)

CIA has received information indicating that the subject, currently Panamanian Ambassador to Great Britain, allegedly is collaborating with the Castro Government. CIA further has been informed that Arias arrived in New York City on or about February 1, 1961, and that he eventually was traveling to Miami. (S) (U)

Mrs. Roman stated that in view of the above allegation, CIA is most interested in receiving any information which might be developed by the Bureau concerning subject's activities and travel in the United States. If he has departed the United States CIA would like to be apprised of any available data pertaining to his travel itinerary. (S) (U)

CIA assumes that subject is traveling with a diplomatic passport. (S) (U)
