This will confirm State Department clearance granted orally by liaison channels for an FDI investigation of the captioned subject who is the Panamanian Ambassador to Great Britain. (S)

Information has been received from another Government agency engaged in intelligence investigations that Arias reportedly arrived in the United States at New York City on or about February 1, 1961, and is collaborating with the Castro government. (S)

NOTE: In 1959 Arias was active in revolutionary attempt to overthrow the existing Panamanian Government and sought aid from the Castro government. Part of his force was captured when it landed in Panama. The subject sought asylum in the Brazilian Embassy in Panama on 4/24/59 and was later granted permission to travel to Brazil. When the present Panamanian President Roberto F. Chiari took over the Government, he named subject Ambassador to Great Britain. Information has been received from CIA that subject reportedly
