17. The subject has been involved in an alleged kidnapping, an assault and possibly espionage activities while in Washington, D. C., which have been previously reported to the Bureau. The tesur was instituted to broaden our coverage of his activities. Specifically, following the break in diplomatic relations between the United States and Cuba and prior to the discontinuance of WF 1133-S\* it was reported by that informant that the subject and the Cuban OAS Mission in Washington, D. C., would be used as the contact point for communications between various July 26 Movement groups and Havana, Cuba, possibly for espionage purposes. Since the source is in a position to furnish valuable information which could not be obtained elsewhere and in order for the Bureau to be able to fulfill its responsibilities in the security field, it is recommended that the coverage be continued for another 30 days, to afford a fair evaluation of this source. At that time, this matter will be re-evaluated and appropriate recommendations will be submitted.
