MMAD further advised BIBERMAN that she had had a very interesting meeting last night and that the Commander of the American Legion, whom she described as "My old pal" wanted to have lunch with her as soon as she got over her illness. HERBERT expressed great enthusiasm about this and stated that he was very satisfied that everything was going fine and added that the most important thing to do at present was to push forth with the meeting.

This meeting, which is described in this conversation, is a mass meeting which the R.W.R. is contemplating as the climax to its drive for funds, according to Temporary Confidential Mational Defence Informant L. A. #5. Because of the limitation on crowds set by General DeWITT of the Fourth Interceptor Command, it is not probable that a large mass rally will be held, according to this Informant. Crowds presently are limited to five thousand persons. This Informant advised that arrangements were presently under way to secure DONOTHY THOMPSON; noted columnist as the main speaker at this rally, and further it has been proposed that instead of one large mass rally that a series of rallies be held at different places on the same evening with THOMPSON and others not yet decided upon, to be transported from meeting to meeting for brief appearances. In this way the limitation upon crowds would be solved,

spot checks at the Hussian Consulate during the evening of Wednesday, January 28, 1942 but failed to discover any reception in progress there. Furthermore, Confidential National Defense Informant L.A. \$1029 checked the various projection rooms of the motion picture companies, where the Consulate had previously held private showings of films, with negative results.
