NY 2858-S* made the information available on 5/10/61. (S)(u)

The attached memo is classified "Confidential" since information furnished by the source could reasonably result in the identification of this source which would impair his future effectiveness, which impairment could have an adverse effect upon the national defense of the US.

For the information of LA, the subject visited CP National Headquarters, 23 West 26th St., NYC, on 5/10/61, and made the comments concerning his travel plans during the visit. (S)(u)

The subject was identified through NY 2858-S* by SA DONALD CHAPIN. (S)(u)

For information of LA, the "SS Batory", GYDRIA American Line sails from Montreal, Canada, approximately the second week of each month. Subject's departure can only be verified when and if RCMP makes available to the Bureau a copy of the ship's manifest. (S)
