*Information was recently received through the Central Intelligence Agency indicating that Gibson, leader of the pro-Castro Fair Play for Cuba Committee, had indicated an interest in talking with representatives of the United States Government and specifically with representatives of the Central Intelligence Agency. In view of this Bureau's investigative interest in both Gibson and the Fair Play for Cuba Committee, arrangements were made for him to be interviewed and there is attached a memorandum dated August 27, 1962, which sets forth the results of this interview.

As noted in the attached memorandum, Gibson has denied any knowledge of Cuban government subsidization of the Fair Play for Cuba Committee but has offered to assist either the Fair Play for Cuba Committee or the Central Intelligence Agency in return for financial remuneration. In view of Gibson's obviously untrustworthy character, no steps are being taken to accept his offer and we are not initiating any future contacts with him.

We are advising the Central Intelligence Agency and Department of State of the results of our interview with Gibson.
