Re Miami letter and LHM 6/10/65 and Mexico City letter 12/28/64.

Following receipt of the Miami communications of reference, subject's status was discussed with the Chief of the Mexican Immigration Inspection Department, CRESCENCIANO CAMPOS, on 6/28/65, and he advised that he would review the records of his agency and make certain that an alert for subject was still outstanding which would eliminate the possibility of subject's obtaining a Mexican Transit Visa in Havana without the knowledge and approbation of the Mexican Immigration Department. (G-1)(u)

On 8/9/65, Mr. CAMPOS assured that the main files of the Mexican Immigration Department contain a look-out notice for the subject which would result in notification to Mr. CAMPOS in the event a request is received for a Mexican Transit authorization in behalf of subject. He also stated that the Chief of the Mexican Immigration Office at the International Airport had also been notified with respect to the subject in order that he be placed under control should he arrive at the airport from Cuba without proper documents. (G-1)(u)

Since it does not appear that further action is required in Mexico with respect to captioned case, it is considered RUC herewith. (G-1)(u)

One copy hereof is being designated for the Washington Field Office which has an investigative interest in subject.
