ReBulet dated 11/8/62, to WFO, captioned PSI - DESECO - R"

Relet refers to information furnished by PSI (whose identity is to be kept confidential) ascertaining the attempted compromise of ALINE MOSBY, a United Press International (UPI) correspondent in Moscow. ReBulet points out that ALINE MOSBY has been considered a possible suspect in instant case, and that the possibility exists that the Soviet activity succeeded in such compromise efforts.

ReBulet instructs present assignment of Miss MOSBY be ascertained.

The above-mentioned PSI who is a newspaper-(man employed at UPI, advised SA TOLLEF JACOBSON on 11/25/62, CS that the instance previously described by him in which the Russians attempted to compromise ALINE MOSEY-presumably occurred some time within approximately the last 6 months to Miss MOSBY was (S) a year, inasmuch as, according to transferred from her UPI assignment at Moscow about 6 months saidIS ago, as a result of the instance referred to. Miss MOSBY, at that time, was transferred from Moscow to Paris, France, and he knows she is still in Paris, because he has recently seen her byline on a news story emanating from that city.

In view of the above information concerning the whereabouts of ALINE MOSBY, no further consideration is being given to her as a possible suspect in instant case, in asmuch as the unsub is understood to be located in the Washington, D. C. area. 1.1
