On 11/16/65 and 11/24/65, Sergio Hermogenes Sanchez Suarez, mechanic at Tino-American, 7661 N.W. 7th Avenue, Miami, and Reinaldo Padron Quintana (105-147035) respectively advised that they had no plans to attempt an assassination of Fidel Castro. They both stated they were not acquainted with Antonia Veciana (no locality).

On 1/12/66, MM 847-S advised that Antonio Veciana was among the Cuban exiles who supported the "Cuban Center for Political Studies" of Miami. The Center was also supported by the SFNE and the Junta Revolucionaria Cubana (105-114543).

The CIA advised that James C. Cogswell\*, who reportedly had high-level contacts in society and US Navy, in April, 1966, introduced the CIA representative to one Antonio Veciana Blanch, a former leader of A-66, who wanted \$50,000 from the CIA to organize a group to assassinate Fidel Castro to which the CIA declined.

The following references in the file captioned "Partido De La Revolucion Aka Centro Cubano de Estudios Politicos" (CCEP), pertain to Antonio Carlos Veciana Blanch, a Cuban exile, from mid October, 1965 to 8/20/66 in Florida and PR. Veciana was a leading participant in the formation of the CCEP and became a member of the Finance Committee. Veciana attended the planning meeting for the CCEP Congress to be held 2/2-5/67.
