ing this film, such as what type of material was supposed to have been contained on it, or exactly when or where ZAITSEV had received the film from the agent. Informant said, in other words, that ZAITSEV did not in any way relate any information which would help in identifying the agent who had used the movie film.

Informant said he is quite sure that it was not "BERG" who furnished ZAITSEV with this film because he is sure, from ZAITSEV's remarks, that "BERG" continues to use a still camera. Earlier informant had thought that ZAITSEV had purchased a movie camera for "BERG".

Information Concerning YURI NOSENKO's Knowledge of Colonel VALENTIN ZAITSEV

NY airtel, 2/22/64, beginning on page 9, contained information reflecting that YURI NOSENKO, the Soviet intelligence officer who defected to American intelligence in Geneva, Switzerland, recently, had knowledge of Colonel VALENTIN ZAITSEV by virtue of a KGB operation carried out in Moscow against an American tourist, which operation was personally conducted by NOSENKO himself.

During the interview of 3/9/64, informant advised that during the recent past, while in conversation with VALENTIN ZAITSEV, ZAITSEV stated that while he was in Moscow on vacation in 1963, he personally met YURI NOSENKO. Informant said he was somewhat surprised to hear this inasmuch as he was not aware previously that Colonel ZAITSEV and NOSENKO had ever personally met.

A check of the Mosnat card maintained in the NYO on Colonel VALENTIN ZAITSEV reflects that he was absent from the US in 1963, only during the period 9/25/63 to 10/28/63 It is believed this period was shortly after the time that BERNARD KOTEN was arrested by Soviet authorities in Moscow.

Comments Made by ALEKSANDR TELMINOV Concerning NIKOLAI B RODIN, Former KGB Chief in London

Informant said that some days previously, he could not recall the exact date, while having a conversation with ALEKSANDR TELMINOV, the name of NIKOLAI. B. RODIN came up. Informant pointed out that he has previously identified RODIN as the former Chief of the KGB Residency in London, England. TELMINOV told the informant that RODIN was in London as Chief of the KGB Residency there for some 7 years. For the first years he was there he had the KGB code name ROSS". (3) TELMINOV said that subsequently, SHEIEPIN became the Chief of the KGB in boscow, at which the it was learned that SHEIEPIN found the name "ROSS" to be quite distasteful. It then became necessary for RODIN to change his code name in deference to SHEIEPIN. It was then that he took the code name ROSOV" Informant pointed out that some months ago he had furnished "ROSOV" to interviewing agents as RODIN's code name.

Informant's Comments Concerning YURI NOSENKO

Informant said that recently he received a letter from his old friend in Moscow, VADIM A. KIPTENKO, an employee of the Scientific Directorate of the KGB. In this letter KIPTENKO wrote that Major STANISLAV NAZARYEV will not be coming to the US in order to take over the STB of the KGB Washington, D.C. Residency. KIPTENKO said this decision not to send NAZARYEV to the US, was based on the fact that it is known that YURI NOSENKO has personal knowledge of NAZARYEV.
