As can be seen, and as the informant pointed out, this information was received from PIROGOV, under very restrictive circumstances, in the course of a personal conversation. For this reason, informant urged that this data be handled with the utmost care and discretion, in order to assure that his personal security is in no way jeopardized by furnishing this information to the interviewing agents.

In line with this, the enclosed LHM has been prepared reflecting a Washington, D. C. dateline, rather than a New York dateline. No reference to VIKTOR I. PIROGOV has been made in the enclosed LHM, as being the source who made this information available to the informant.

In reference to the information set forth in the enclosed memorandum concerning SERGEI GOLUBEV, informant said that GOLUBEV was in NY during the past week and while in the KGB quarters, informant engaged him in conversation. GOLUBEV, whom the informant identified as being the Chief of "Line KR" (Counterintelligence) in the KGB Residency in Washington, D. C., furnished the enclosed information concerning his return to the Soviet Union to the informant, at that time. Informant noted that SERGEI GOLUBEV is known under the KGB code name "GROMOV". (S)

The enclosed LHM has been classified "Top Secret", in order to afford the best possible protection to the informant, who is a defector-in-place.

In the event the Bureau disseminates the enclosed to CIA, the NYO would appreciate having the benefit of any comments or observations made by CIA concerning this data.
