Re Bureau airtel, 7/7/65, enclosing CIA memorandum of 6/30/65, captioned, "Bona Fides of SCOTCH," classified "Secret;" Bulet of 6/7/65 to CIA bearing the same caption.

With respect to the referenced memorandum of CIA, it is generally observed that this is the latest in the series of CIA communications conforming to CIA's overall pattern of attempting to discredit "SCOTCH" (NY 3653-S\*). (Refer to previous CIA communications of 8/13/64, captioned, "SCOTCH;" 4/30/65, captioned "NOSENKO-SCOTCH;" 5/14/65, captioned, "Bona Fides of SCOTCH.")
