[On 7/5/65, U. S. Customs, Miami, advised that information in the above-mentioned CIA report does not indicate any apparent U. S. Customs violation.] The information is non-specific; Customs has not opened any case on it; and Customs does not plan an investigation at this time. ~~(S)~~ (u)

On 7/12/65, MM 639-S advised he was previously associated with LUIS POSADA CARRILES, and has several friends in the military section of RECE. Informant said he will immediately establish contact with POSADA and RECE to effect coverage on this alleged operation. (S) (u)

OTHER 4

For the information of the Bureau, [redacted] has been contacted in the past by the Miami Office concerning JURE, an anti-CASTRO organization. He has been cooperative and stated he has been a paid CIA informant in the past six months and desired to cooperate with the Bureau. However, he did not want to jeopardize his CIA pay check and requested his identity be concealed. The last contact with [redacted] was on 6/10/65. (S) (u)

CIA, on 7/13/65, stated that agency would check to ascertain if they had an operational interest in POSADA or an operation to blow up a ship in the harbor of Veracruz, Mexico. (S) (u)

Miami will follow activities of RECE through established sources and informants until it is ascertained if [CIA has an operational interest] or if the Department of Justice desires an active investigation. ~~(S)~~ (u)
