Jacksonville indices reflect in LHM dated 9/12/74 with Jacksonville airtel to Bureau of same date in this case reports a CHARLES R. HALL as a frequent correspondent of subject PHILLIPS. Also file reflects subject PHILLIPS a weekly correspondent with a MIKE OLIVER, P.O. Box 485, Carson City, Nevada.

It is noted that Jacksonville indices are negative concerning JOHN MULDOON, WALTER MACKEN, TED ROUSSOS, COL. ROBERT BAYARD and FRANK BOND, all of whom are mentioned in enclosed article; however, Jacksonville files disclose information concerning MITCHELL L. WER BELL, Jacksonville file 157-903, entitled, Lt. Col. PAUL A. MARIOTTE, Agent of Weapons; Racial Matters. Bureau letter to Jacksonville dated 12/8/69 under above caption disclosed that Bureau files do contain considerable amount of
