The captioned movement is involved in efforts to separate Abaco (in the Bahamas) from the Bahamas and we have been aware of these efforts for some time. MI-5 has recently furnished us report which was transmitted to field by Bureau letter 2/7/75. Jacksonville on 1/29/75, transmitted magazine article which essentially deals with the same matter. We are aware of the participation of many of the individuals in this activity.
