SUBJECT: United States v. Mitchel Werbell, III  
Southern District of Florida

Two members of the Narcotic and Dangerous Drug Section of the Criminal Division are the trial attorneys in the above-mentioned case in the Southern District of Florida. On August 30, 1976, the trial judge issued an order which required the prosecutors to ask several agencies including the Federal Bureau of Investigation some questions. The questions that the Federal Bureau of Investigation must answer are these questions:

- 1) Has any money been paid to any of the individuals or corporations listed below by the Federal Bureau of Investigation?
- 2) Has the Federal Bureau of Investigation had any contacts with the individuals or corporations listed below that resulted in the Federal Bureau of Investigation being given any information by those individuals or corporations?
