5/19/64 and Miami airtel to Bureau 3/19/64.

The San Juan Office and the New York Office,
by letters May 20 and 28, 1964, respectively, advised
that sources contacted by them were negative concerning U
subject.

The Bureau, by letter dated May 19, 1964, re-
quested Miami comments concerning the potential of MARGER
for development as a source in the Dominican field.

Bureau is referred to referenced Miami airtel
or March 19, 1964 and LHM which accompanied airtel. It
is noted that LESLIE BALOGH BAIN reportedly said that
MARGER had been BAIN's friend and attorney for some U
period of time.

Miami files contain information regarding
LESLIE BALOGH BAIN which originated with CIA, indicating
that BAIN was pro-Soviet and critical of the United
States federal and state governments. (S)(U)

The Miami Office does not feel any attempt
should be made to solicit MARGER's assistance or any
action taken which would allow MARGER to claim at any
time he had been cooperating with the Bureau on a
regular basis, as it is felt such action could result U
in possible future embarrassment to the Bureau.
