On April 27, 1973, a confidential source abroad, furnished the following information:

Recently, it was learned that ERRINGTON W. WATKINS, member of Parliament, Bahamas House of Assembly, from Abaco Island, was in London, England. WATKINS talked with the British about Abaco seceding from the Bahama Islands when the Islands receive their independence on July 10, 1973. WATKINS desires that Abaco remain under British control. *(G-1)(u)*

With WATKINS was an American named MITCHELL WERBELL, President of Defense Systems International, Powder Springs, Georgia, and another American named EDWIN MARGER, a 44-year-old lawyer, not further identified. *(G-1)(u)*

On May 2, 1973, a second source who has furnished reliable information in the past, furnished the following information:

On April 13, 1973, the Wackenhut Corporation, Miami, Florida, a company which trains and furnishes security guards, was contacted by PAUL BETHEL, MITCHELL L. WERBELL, III, CHARLES BALL, and two other
