Enclosed for the Bureau are ten copies of a LHM
reflecting interview of subject. One information copy of this
LHM is being furnished to Albany, Miami and New York to
complete their files in captioned matter.

The sources referred to in the LHM in the order

and NY (4883-S) ~~(S)~~ (u)

The interview of the subject was conducted on 9/19/67
by SAS MERWIN E. MELLOR and WILLIAM J. DAVIS. The subject
greeted SAS warmly and was effusive in expressing both his
praise of the FBI and his devotion to the democratic system
as epitomized by the United States. He seemed most anxious
to cooperate with the Bureau. It is felt however, that
the subject's effusiveness may have been a compensatory
effort on his part to cover his lack of candor in discussing
the full scope of his activities. If full credit is given
to the sources of information regarding the subject's involve-
ment in violence, it becomes obvious that he is withholding
information concerning this aspect of his affairs.
