On 10/26/67 Detective Constable MCKAY, London Airport Police, advised as follows:

On 10/26/67 ROBERT SANTIAGO, occupation self-employed public relations man, possessing U.S. Passport G-1125184 issued New York, U.S. address 14850 South Spur Drive, Miami, appeared at the Swissair ticket counter. He presented two tickets valued at \$732 each, which were issued 5/7/67 on an American Express credit card to SAM BENTON, 2121 North Bayside Drive, Miami. SANTIAGO wanted the routing on the tickets changed and he wanted a cash voucher for the balance. When questioned, he claimed that BENTON had given the tickets to him. SANTIAGO now claims to be resident in London.
