- 1. On 12 April 1961, Frank Fiorini, an ex-Marine who fought with Castro until he defected, called our New York office to report the following incident. Recently, Fiorini was trying to locate a particular Cuban in the Mismi area and was told by a Dr. Ramon Ruiz, Vice President of Sea Highway, Inc., in Mismi (telephone: HI-67569) that the Cuban was located at a CIA base called New Found Harbor, located Mear Big Pine Key, 14 miles south of Marathon, Florids.
- 2. Fiorini went to the location but did not find his friend. However, he noticed a number of vessels including two PT boats. One was numbered FL-522LE.
- 3. According to Fiorini, Ruiz was at one time associated with the FBI but is now an intelligence agent for Micaragua and has excellent connections with Somoza.
