Confirmation of Verbal Request for Installation of Recording Device in Office of Er. Villiam D. Pawley, Miami, Florida

I. This will confirm the werbal request made to Fr. Langdon of your office by of WH/III on 5 October 1959 for the installation of a recording device in the office of Mr. William D. Pawley in Hiami, Florida, for the purpose of making available to the WHD Representative in Fismi detailed reports of conversations held by Mr. Pawley with his numerous contacts among Caribbean revolutionary groups, especially anti-CASTRO Cuban exile leaders. Mr. Pawley has agreed to this plan, which was proposed to him verbally by the WHD representative in Hiami.

- 2. Mr. Pawley is a U. S. citizen, born 7 September 1893. His long career in Latin American affairs included a tour as U. S. Ambassador to Peru and later to Brazil. In recent years he has engaged in petroleum and mining activities in the Deminican Republic and has served as a consultant to the Deminican Government. He has cooperated with this Agancy on a number of occasions and is a personal friend of the DCI and of CWH. A request for operational approval or security clearance for Mr. Pawley's use in a specific project was made in 1952 but cancelled subsequently because of a change in plans. Mr. Kohler of CI/OA advised that the Security Office File No. in connection with this request was #78435. It is requested that your office obtain the necessary security clearance for Mr. Pawley's use by this Agency, as outlined in paragraph 1.
- 3. Since Mr. Pawley's office is vacated on week-ends, it is requested that a representative from your office travel to Miamicon Friday, 8 October, or Saturday, 9 October, for the purpose of surveying the premises during this week-end; and that he return to Miami the following week-end to install the recording device, which is to be used only for callers in person, and not by telephone. On arrival in Miami, your representative should call Mr. Bernard E. Reichhardt, WHD representative in Miami, who shares an office with the CO Contacts representative, Room 302, 299 Alhambra Circle, Coral Gables. His home telephone is MO 5-4238, and his office number is Highland 5-3658.
