




- 1. In the course of our research of files pertaining to areas of the USSR in which Lee Harvey OSWALD allegedly resided, a photograph of an individual closely resembling OSWALD was uncovered.
- 2. Cur files indicate that this photograph (Attachment A) came CIT: USA.

  from a color transparency taken in Linea. USAL, on or about 1! August FEMALE 1761, by an American tourist, here. Menica E. RAMER, whose address at the time was F. O. Box 983, Selvang, California. USA.
- I. The photograph appears to have been taken in Teentrai'naya Floshchad' (Central Square), which is located in the center of Minek. The building in the background has been identified as The Falace of Culture. Six people are depicted in the photograph. The individual second from the right, appears to be Lee harvey OSWALD. It should be noted that the shirt this individual is nearing appears to be identical to the shirt OSWALD is wearing in two photographs from the group of 47 photographs from the effects of OSWALD which were forwarded to this Agency in your communication of SwALD which were forwarded to this employed. Assassization of President John F. KENNEDY. Copies of these two photographs of OSWALD are forwarded with this report as Attachment B.
- 4. Source of the photograph identified one of the females in the picture, possibly the one on the left, as Svetlans (LNU), an interist guide. Source was accompanied by another American, blue Rita NAMAN, 595 Attardes

- 5. Mrs. ERAMER and Miss HAMAN, both of whom are United States citizens, were contacted by this Agency on a one-time basis, following their return from their tear of the USER. The report of this contact, OC-2-3, 212, 767, dated 21 March 1952, subject: Realities/Titor Farade/Interrogation in Missis Following the Civing Away of a US News Magazine, in forwarded as Attachment C.
- 6. Mrs. ERAMER, who is described as "an older companion" in the source description of Attachment C. furnished this Agency with 150 color transparencies taken during the trip. Attachment A is only one of the five transparencies of which negative copies were made and retained by this Agency. All of the 160 original color transparencies were returned to live. ERAMER.
- 7. Miss Makian, referred to as "a calluge graduate" in the source description of Attachment C, provided this agency with one rest of time color mevic film taken dering the trip. The film was viewed by this Agency and was subsequently returned to biss Makian.
- II. This Agency has had no further contact with either here.

  ERAMER or hits Bahlah subsequent to the contact reflected in the report forwarded as Attachment C.
- 7. This office would be interested in any partinent information which interviews of here. KRAMER and hass RAMAN by your office weight possibly provide along the following lines:
  - a. A more positive identification of the individual in Attachment A tenistively identified as OSWALD.
  - b. The exact date and estimate of the time of day when the photograph (Attachment A) was taken.

/c. Any information

- c. Any information which would aid in identifying other individuals in the photograph (Attachment A).
- d. The same, address, and any other identifying data on the traveling companion who accompanied hire. ERAMER and Miss MAMAN from hissons to Farsaw via Missk.
- 19. Dissemination of Attachment A and portinent identifying information to the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy is being delayed pending receipt of your Dursan's findings in this matter.
