MEMORANDUM FOR THE DIRECTOR

SUBJECT : Meeting with LITANIE-L-9, 17 July 1963

1. An unexpected meeting was held with LITANIE-L-9 at 0100 hours 17 July -- Barker had a scheduled meeting with AMSAIL-1 at the corner of Ejercito Nacional and Melchor Ocampo at 2100 hours but A-1 was two minutes late at 2103 when B made his second pass -- B then stopped by the corner of Gutenberg and Thiers where there is a pay phone -- to make a call to A-1 -- but as B's car pulled up, LITANIE-L-9 stepped out of the bushes and said, in English, "Here I am." L-9 got in the car and [redacted] drove away -- the mystery was clarified when L-9 explained that he had called B's home about 2030 hours and spoken with B's wife who said he was out and would probably be back in about half an hour -- L-9 was en route to Mexico again (from the pay phone at Gutenberg & Thiers -- usual pick-up point) when he saw Barker pass by -- L-9 later spotted the car pull up at the corner -- he assumed by this time that Barker had spoken with his B's wife, had received the word that L-9 was looking for him that night -- what a coincidence! L-9 explained his presence in the area (partly true) by saying he was on the way for better pick up locations -- no mention was made of another scheduled meeting (with A-1). [redacted] drove on the Monterrey highway to the vicinity of the Dawn Motel where the meeting was held. L-9 was dropped off at 2325 hours.

2. L-9 revealed again his concern about security -- how the new ambassadors and cultural attachés are such sharp people, hence much more dangerous. The elements of a complete clandestine communication system were explained "a la CIA regular," scheduled and non-scheduled, security, and warning -- and some provisions were made for working out the details.

3. L-9 reported that he was due to furnished [redacted]

4. He reported the following additional developments:

(a) A big celebration of the 20th of July [redacted] will be held in Tlalnepantla, suburb of Tijuana. This celebration -- sponsored by the Hugo Gómez Martí -- will take place in the salón de la Cervecería María Victoria (Brewery). The principal speaker will be Victor RICO Galván. The event will take place at 1100 hrs.

L-9 advised that it was to have photographs taken there and might want to drop a stink bomb or two.

(b) Colonel LITANIE-L-9, who was introduced in accordance to KMD during the President's trip to Mexico, has reportedly been promoted to Captain and has apparently quit the service of the Republic, has been invited "to make an application" in the United States and is planning to go there. [redacted] no further details.

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She was introduced to the First Lady by (Mrs) BARRIOS.
Santo (Chonito).

- (c) APANCHO, the new Cuban Ambassador, told [] that CIOUAN TCH (Tch), Cuban Attaché in Moscow, is going to be recalled soon because he has done much harm there to Cuban-Soviet relations.

(d) APANCHO also reported that the magazine PONENTO in Cuba is having serious trouble obtaining newsprint.

(e) APANCHO said that when he was in Prague he had trouble with the clique -- asked to be sent to some other European country -- was surprised at the suddenness of his transfer to Mexico.

(f) (In response to a question as to who should be the man we might most easily recruit among the Embassy staff,) [] said he has doubts about [] Loyalty to the Castro regime. However [] might be recruitable but wouldn't dare do it himself (I assured [] we would never ask him to undertake such a risky venture). [] goes window shopping along San Juan de Letran often -- might be approachable there.

(g) Only two Cubans were invited to the French Ambassador's residence on Bastille Day (14 July) -- Ambassador HENRIQUEZ ARROYO and []. Each went separately but I received []

- (h) At Ecuadorian youth camp ELISEO BOGARTE was in the Embassy on 17 July -- spoke with AMERICUS, the representative of a group of pro-Embre writers in Ecuador on 18 July, together to go to Cuba will probably get there. He has a good book and would -- brought a book as a gift for AMERICUS.

(i) AMERICUS is busy working on the forthcoming marriage of Ambassador which is to take place in Havana. In in dealing privately with a man noted NAMED on this subject, Mexico AMERICUS says that the JC Government has been sending lots of money to have the best of the equipment and the same with AMERICUS -- without success. A check for \$50 dollars, a reasonable subscription fees paid by Mexican delegates to the UN, was sent to AMERICUS.

(j) At the Embassy became suddenly aware of the restrictions on all US currency transactions with Cuba.

(c) I turned over to B (for return) a handbill put out by the Escuela Normal Rural de Santa Teresita Coahuila, dated 10 June 1963, explaining that schools invitation to Fidel Castro to act as sponsor of the 1958-1963 graduating class. Copy attached.

(i) I turned over a pornographic cartoon (for return) distributed by pro-Castro elements in Tampico. Copy not attached.

(m) Wilfredo of the Cuban Consulate, Tampico, reported that Ignacio CALDIRON has a sister residing in Reynosa, Tamaulipas, married to an American of Mexican descent, Luisa may go up to the border to visit her sister soon -- or her mother may make the trip -- details not clear.

5. L-9 reports that he is [redacted]

[redacted] His information gathering method is still to keep his eyes and ears open and ask no questions -- thus he often gets only fragments -- while questions or discreet elicitation might fill in detail he is extremely wary lest he arouse any suspicion.

6. While he suggested [redacted] might want to toss a few stink bombs at the engraving exhibit on the 20th in Tampico and the subsequent celebration of the 26th in Ciudad Madero

felt that the Mexican Government might think the disruption was engineered by the Castro Cubans, themselves, to throw suspicion off the anti-Castroites.

7. L-9 is really worried about his security and it will be up to us to take every practical precaution to protect him. He loves to talk -- quite a conversationalist -- and needs constant encouragement and shoring-up. He is [redacted] inclined to rest himself on the back quite often and wait for a further pat from his care officer (which B is always quick to add). This characteristic comes out in his conversation when he stops and says, "I did very well there, didn't I?" or "That was a good [redacted] idea I had, wasn't it?" or "I think my ideas on handling such-and-such are pretty clever, don't you?"

8. For the present it has been decided to keep holding meetings in B's car -- always at night. The pick up point has been abandoned in favor of a mobile pick up -- [redacted] will start at the corner of Thiers and Melchor Ocampo at the prescribed hour and walk slowly up the street to Thiers and Gutenberg -- then, without turning, will work his way back down the opposite side of the street to Melchor Ocampo -- B will cruise by in his car and make the pick up while [redacted] is walking. Other car/no details will be worked out at the next meeting.
