Subject came to see Chief of Station "confidentially" on 6 February 1964. He said:

- a. He wishes to resign from his present job and organization effective 1 July 1964 and he wants to remain in Mexico.
- b. He wants a contract with KUBARK which will permit him to keep his retirement pay (something over \$6,000.00 dollars annually plus a salary from KUBARK equal to his present salary (about \$15,500.00 dollars plus 1,000 annually for "overtime") plus school and rental allowances. This would mean a total income from ODYORIS of over \$22,500.00 plus schooling and rental allowances.
- c. Subject states he offers:
  - a. Excellent contacts in the Ministry of Gobernacion at medium and "near top" levels; excellent contacts at all levels in the Metropolitan Police of Mexico City; very good contacts in the Police Bureau and Directing Office of the Attorney General of the Republic of Mexico and very good contacts at all levels in the office of the Attorney General of the Federal District.
  - b. A pre-arranged cover as salesman for Pan American Insurance Company. Subject states he can get innigraide papers at once - and can donate just enough to this "salesman" job to appear to be interested in, in addition to his retired income.

c. Bilingual Spanish.

d. Some contacts in the Mexican and American business communities.

As is known to Headquarters, this Station already has excellent contacts in Government at all levels; Chief of Station knows the Chief of the Metropolitan Police well and two of his principal assistants; and Chief of Station knows the Attorney General for the Federal District and his principal aides. The Station presently has good contacts with the Acting Attorney General for the Republic, but these could be developed if needed and very rapidly.

Also, changes will very likely be made in all these ministries and agencies in December 1961 - as soon as Lic. Gustavo DIAZ Ordaz becomes President of Mexico and the incoming President is a close personal friend of Chief of Station, so that contacts with any needed or desirable group can be easily established after 1 December 1961.

b. Chief of Station, therefore, recommends that Subject be advised that:

a. KUBARK appreciates very much his offer to become a part of the Mexican effort - but that his price is far too expensive for KUBARK.

b. Should he get a commercial job in Mexico or any other foreign area where KUBARK has jurisdiction, KUBARK would like to consider him as a contact - but at a much lower rate of pay than he is requesting.

c. ODEWY would need to be advised of his employment by KUBARK in any capacity in Mexico which would entail contacts with the four groups he has listed, because ODEWY would certainly learn of his continued relations with these groups.

d. An early reply would be appreciated so that Subject will know well in advance of KUBARK's intentions regarding Subject.
