Talking to Hank Schorr today, he passed the following interesting detail on HSCA requests:

CCS now holds for HSCA review some 1,850 documents on individuals on whom requests were made, plus another 414 documents on organizations. This covers about 30 individuals (there was no record in CCS on a much larger number of people). He adds that he could not tell me how many files were involved, nor how many pages there were per document.

He states that no one from HSCA has come down to look at the first document.

He states that CCS is up to date on all requests received by it, which has been reported to SA/DDO (now Shepanek).

I wonder if this has been reported to HSCA people, and in what form. And what does HSCA understand to be its responsibility to review material when reported ready for review?
