Future Plans of Alpha-66 - WH-765

1. The source of the following information, which was received on 2 November 1962, is Robert Pratchett, [redacted] New York, New York: 05, 08

a. From Alpha 66 contact point in New York, with assurances relayed from Puerto Rico headquarters and Miami source, there is an assurance that Alpha 66 will not muddy the existing waters in the Cuban crisis by mounting any further action against Castro forces in Cuba.

b. Once Soviet missiles have been removed from Cuba, and there is a definite indication of cessation of US forces surveillance of the island by Naval blockade or overflights of aerial reconnaissance, Alpha 66 states through its command channels that it intends to renew armed activity with intensity, on land and by sea. Their capability is presently for at least five more raids, with sufficient funds and arms to carry out with guaranteed degree of success.

c. Alpha 66 is satisfied that present US action and intentions are directed in favor of the Cuban future. Should US military movements indicate a discontinuance of watchdog action which has currently neutralized Castro's expansion of force and Communist doctrine, Alpha 66 will take matters into their own hands for whatever harassment purpose it may serve.
