March 1923 at New York, and his wife, Mollie BLOCK, aged 27,
 nationals, arrived on 15 April 1949 at Southampton from
New York en route to Gdynia in the Polish S.S. Satory. Their
destination is believed to be Warsaw. According to a reliable
informant, who travelled with them from New York, BLOCK and his
wife endeavoured to get permission to hold a public meeting
on board during the crossing, but when this was refused they
contented themselves by holding a small meeting in the Tourist
lounge on the morning of 9 April. In the course of this meeting
both BLOCK and his wife spoke very disparagingly of the Atlantic
Pact and from the tone of their remarks, the informant gained
the impression that they were Communists.

3 The following descriptions have been given of this
couple:

Morris BLOCK: 5'11"; medium build; complexion fresh;
clean-shaven; lean features; hair light brown, wavy and brushed
up and back; eyes light blue; good teeth; scar on chin.
