to Receive Madrid Club Award to her Husband

1. A sensitive source has reported that Mrs. Martin Luther KING is being invited to Madrid, Spain, by the Friends of UNESCO Club of Madrid (CAUM). She is to receive an award being presented posthumously to her husband. The presentation is scheduled for 10 December 1968.

2. The award called the "CAUM Prize," is to be presented annually to individuals who have worked in support of "human rights." Designated as the 1968 recipient, Dr. KING will be the first to receive the prize.
