(Field Comment: The following report should be read in conjunction with TDCS-314/01096-68 (EDS)4065) and 22(139-4099), which reported that Fernando Molo Fontanills, a Cuban exile in Costa Rica, was serving as an intermediary in negotiations between Ladvig Starke Jimenez, a Costa Bican right-wing entremist, and Eclando Eaglerrer, a Cuban cuile in the United States who was involved in plotting against the government of President Rone Davalier of Easti. The acgotiations dealt with a plan whereby Starke would provide a staging area for an invasion of Eaiti by Eaitian and Cuban onilos under Masserrer's leadership. In return Masforror, if successful, would subsequently support a nove by Starke against the Costa Bican Government. Belo was reported to be planning a trip to New York on 21 February 1968 to talk with Manferrer and the latter's representative in the negotiations, Father Diego Madrigal Alvarez.)

When Helo returned to San Jose on 2 Earch after vigiting Now York City and Hismi, Florida, he was detained and conrehed by security officials at the airport. Among Molo's possessions the security officials found a letter, signed by Holo, addressed to Father Diego Eadrigal, Evo York. The letter was dated 9 February 1968. It was typewritten on letterhead stationery of Rogelio R. Pinto Impresos. Rican Service) Comment: Helo sells printing equipment and thus may have a hasiness connection with the Pinto fire; however, Rogel for Finto has been reported in the past to have been involved in plotting against the Costa Bican Government.)

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
