- c. One of Hasferrer's men who went to the Deminican Republic corrying a small quantity of arms and ammunities had been approhended by Deminican authorities despite the fact that the men had declared that the arms were for cale to the military. Santiago Roy Perma, Cuban emigro in the Deminican Republic, had been unable to intercede since he has lost his influence with the government of President Josquin Balaguer.
- d. Pather Georges will be the leader of the Haitien "insurrection."
- 4. Kasferrar said that in view of the arrest of his smishary in the Deminican Republic he was returning to New York for a few days until all was calm again. He added that the help of lubert and certain other friends in the Deminican Republic was being given without the approval of the Balaguer government.
- 5. On 2 October 1966 Eugone L. Haminilien, Haitian Comoul General in Missi, caid that Father Georges' visit to Missi was to make a payment for war materials and vessels purchased by Masferrer. Maniallien said that Father Georges had received 62,000 from Paul Hagloire, former President of Haiti, about two weeks carlier and 67,000 from Canada. Maximilien said he did not know who sent the meney from Canada.

Course of the information in paragraphs 6 - 8: A member of a group of Cuban calgres trained in the techniques of information collection. The group has provided useful reports since 1961.

- In late September Manuel Olea, Cuban emigre, each that Masserrer bad brought him from New York to take part in an operation egainst the Haitian regime. Olea said that in New York Masserrer had told him that he (Olea) would be chief of operations. According to Olea, American newspaperwen were with them from the time they left New York until they arrived in Mismi, taking motion pictures all the time. He remarked that since arriving in Mismi he had found Masserrer's activities wery strange. He added that he thought nothing definite was going to take place, and that he had decided that he would not take part in the precedings.
- 7. Oleo cold that when he had coked Hapferrar for come gums for practice chasting Masferrar had offered him some rifles but had told him that he would have to buy his own bullets. He added that most of the gums Masferrar had users useless. Further, Oleo cold, he had noticed that a man he knew only as Papito" was closely associated with Masferrar and also worked for the Haitian Consul in Mismi. When "Papito" had learned that Masferrar was thinking of transferring his group to the Deminican Republic he had immediately obtained a Deminican visa.
- Olea complained that Masferror had given him only \$100 in Missi, and that he had spent about \$550 for room and board for himself and three others. He added that he had had an argument with Masferror because the plan was not a serious matter. Two of Olea's party had returned to New York and did not plan to come back to Missi.
