In June 1972, DCD was advised by a WH Division staffer that one Rolando MASPERRER, Jr, whom the staffer had personally known in the Miami area, was about to become VP of Sales for MAC in Washington, D. C. Masferrer was described as the son of Rolando Avcadio MASPERRER y Rojas (201-42669). Our Washington office had no contact with the junior Masferrer, but in May and June of 1973, he initiated contact with the DCD Miami office and provided information concerning the efforts of one Guillermo YGLESIAS to solicit Masferrer's assistance in raising money for secret CIA operations in Latin America.
