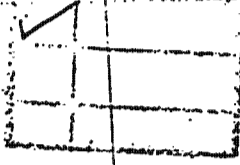

2. From previous correspondence received from the ^{rr} ~~WERC-O.~~, Susan WARREN is believed identical to Susan Hoiligman FRANK of New York. TANG, Ming chou is believed to be an official of the People's Republic of China International Liaison Department.

On April 17, 1971 we learned that a Susan WARREN arrived in Ottawa from New York via Eastern Airlines and met with New China News Agency representative PU, Chao-min.

2. In conversation with PU, WARREN mentioned that she had recently participated in a discussion concerning China on a New York radio programme.

3. WARREN went on to state that she went to China in 1961 and had visited there for a year and a half. The trip was made possible through her close friend TANG, Ming chou, whom PU also knows. PU enquired if WARREN had met Anna Lee SUNG (Anna Louise STRONG) while in China to which WARREN replied that she had although she "knew her from here too". PU made arrangements for WARREN to meet with representatives of the People's Republic of China Mission in Ottawa.
